

Patient Instructions for TEEs and Cardioversions

You will be notified of the date and time of your procedure as soon as it has been set up by our scheduling department. Our scheduling process may take a few days due to the fact that many insurance companies require an authorization for this procedure. We appreciate your patience regarding this matter.

Medications and Special Instructions Before the Procedure

- Take a list of your current medications with you to the hospital, including the name of the drug, dosage, and how often.
- Do not eat or drink anything for 6 hours prior to your hospital arrival time, except for your medications.
- If you are on Digoxin, you must hold this medication for 48 hours prior to your procedure.
- You will need a driver to take you home after your procedure. Please plan accordingly. Please note: Both TEEs and Cardioversions require General Anesthesia, which will be scheduled by our scheduling department.
- Please call the office to reschedule if you develop a fever or infection within three days of your procedure.
