

## **Patient Instructions for Carotid Stent Procedure**

You will be notified of the date and time of your procedure as soon as it has been set up by our scheduling department. The process may take a few days due to the fact that many insurance companies require an authorization for this procedure. We appreciate your patience regarding this matter.

## **Medications and Special Instructions Before the Procedure**

- Take a list of your current medications with you to the hospital, including name of the drug, dosage and frequency.
- Start taking 325 mg of aspirin one week prior to the procedure.
- Start taking Plavix one week prior to the procedure. A prescription will be electronically sent to your pharmacy.
- Do not eat or drink anything 6 hours prior to your hospital arrival time, except for a small sip of water for medications. DO NOT take your blood pressure medication the night before or the morning of your procedure.
  You may take all other medications.
- Blood thinners
  - O Coumadin, Warfarin, Pradaxa, Xarelto, Eliquis, Savaysa: should be discontinued 3 days prior to the procedure. If you have not done so, the procedure will need to be rescheduled.
- Diabetic patients
  - Metformin: Needs to be discontinued within 24 hours prior to the procedure. Other drugs that include Metformin are Avandamet, Fortamet, Glucophage, Glucovance, Glumetza
  - o Insulin: Take only half (1/2) of your usual dosage the day of the procedure and the hospital staff will regulate any other dosing of insulin that you may need.

- Please inform your physician immediately if you are allergic to contrast dye.
- You will need a driver to take you home after the procedure. Please plan accordingly.
- Please note: You cannot drive for 2 days after the procedure.
- Please call the office to reschedule if you develop fever or infection within 3 days of your procedure.
